Heath Dept., City License and booth fee are non-refundable after two weeks prior to event.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED!

Operators with food booths must adhere to Riverside County Health Department Codes:

Hats or hair nets, gloves, hot/cold storage, thermometer, hand washing areas, proper fire extinguishers, etc.

Some duplication of sales items will occur, but the Palm Springs Black History Committee will determine the number of duplications.

The first organization or person submitting the above Registration Form will receive first priority.

Food servers should prepare for a heavy influx of people.
